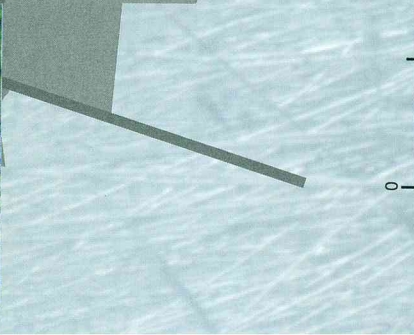




The footpaths around Needingworth Quarry link up with the Ouse Valley Way and other routes to and from the villages of Needingworth and Bluntisham. Industry, agriculture and nature conservation coexist in harmony within this Ouse valley landscape.



Look out for water birds including Tufted Duck, Wigeon, Shelduck and Coot as well as the many wading birds. Many different types of insects can be seen in the reserve particularly in the summer. The most colourful are the butterflies, dragonflies and damselflies.
